**January 27th is Chocolate Cake Day!
Whooh knew!!**

Ever wonder where the first cakes were baked? Well, the Greeks made flat heavy cakes that were served with nuts and honey. The Romans' cakes were more like cheesecake and were presented to their gods as offerings. Citizens of Medieval England used the words 'bread' and 'cake' to refer interchangeably to anything made with a flour dough.

In the 1920s, O. Duff and Sons created the first boxed cake mixes, and in 1947, General Mills released the first 'add water' cake mixes still known today as Betty Crocker cake mixes. At first, only Ginger, Spice, Yellow and White cake mixes were available. In 1948, Pillsbury introduced the first chocolate cake mix. Chocolate remains the most popular cake flavor today.

Can you name all the different types of chocolate cakes? Black Forest, Devil's Food, Flourless, Fudge, Ganache, German Chocolate, Lava, Praline Turtle...and on it goes. If you're up for a chocolate cake taste test, watch for more information on this upcoming chocolaty good time!
